





Rank the priorities listed below from 1 to 10, with 1 being the most important and 10 being the least important.





What shift do you prefer to work?




*There was a significant increase YOY in "found job that paid more money".


What is the minimum amount of shift differential you would require to work and STAY on a shift other than 1st shift?

Which best fits the reason you left your last job?




How much more did your new job pay?

Have you worked 2 jobs simultaneously in the last 12 months?




If you have worked two jobs simultaneously in the last twelve months, how many hours a week was your second job?
